EVERBEARING DAY NEUTRAL - The plants will initiate flower buds during the entire growing season, assuming temperatures do not become too high. These varieties offer instant gratification all season, yielding berries from summer to fall.

EVERBEARING - Despite the name, ever-bearing varieties do not produce all summer long but rather they produce one crop in June and another in summer to fall.

JUNE BEARING - Produce one major crop for a 2-3 weeks in June. Pinch Blooms the first year to establish the plants and to ensure a large crop the second year.

Easy to maintain, strawberries need a sunny area and well-drained, sandy soil for optimum production. Unfortunately, even in the best conditions a strawberry plant will not last for more than six years. So, it's suggested to renew plants every two years to maintain vigorous production.

By using the young plants that are found at the ends of the runners during the active growth period, multiplying strawberry plants is easy.
